*Rabies vaccination for all dogs, cats,  
and ferrets over 3 months  
of age is required in  
Mahoning County.*

- *No appointment necessary.*
- *This is a low-cost clinic that does not include a physical examination of the animal.*
- *Cost is \$6 per shot, cash only.*
- *Pet owners must have their pets on a leash, in a cage, or carried in a cloth pillowcase.*
- *Veterinary staff reserves the right not to vaccinate an animal that appears to be in poor health.*
- *Proof of vaccination on or after December 12, 2014 is required to be eligible for the 3 year booster. All other vaccinations without proof will receive a 1 year vaccination.*

*Did you know?*

- *Rabies is a deadly disease transmitted in saliva.*
- *Cats and dogs are infected with rabies by wild animals every year.*
- *Bites from unvaccinated pets and stray animals could cause human exposure to rabies.*
- *Rabies IS a preventable disease!*

***Protect yourself, your family, and pets from rabies:***

- *Vaccinate all dogs, cats and ferrets against rabies.*
- *Avoid contact with wildlife and stray animals.*
- *If bitten, wash the wound thoroughly and see your doctor.*
